Before the invasion of Iraq, the US and Britain thought it would be easy to set up a regime, but now it is clear that there is no workable plan. Our troops are still taking casualties, and will be there for longer than expected. Iraq is a mess and we don't know what to do about it.

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“Defense Department civilians ... suggested [in February] that a force of about **100,000** American troops might be sufficient at the start and that the figure could quickly taper off.” *New York Times 5/29/03*
